- II. Facilitators These rolesare also open to faculty, faculty librarians, and professional staff. Summer Institutes and Workshops are typically overseen by orte (h)ee (3)facilitators and last from one (1) to three (3) days. Faculty d faculty librarians serving in this capacity will be compensated \$15 per hour for hours of preparation and the duration of the Institute/Workshop*
- III. Mentors and Guest Speaker Faculty and faculty librarians serving as mentors or guest speakers will be compensated \$15 per hour for the duration of their allotted time during the Institute/Workshop.* When an Institute/Workshop is offered by a person whose contractual responsibilities may include offering the Workshop will receive no additional compensation
