

The 1997-2001 annualized rate of change in enrollment in graduate students has attained a new high of 18.5 percent. This is a significant increase over the last year's 5 percent annualized rate of change. The 2001 enrollment of 11,500 students is a record for the university, and is 10% higher than in 2000.

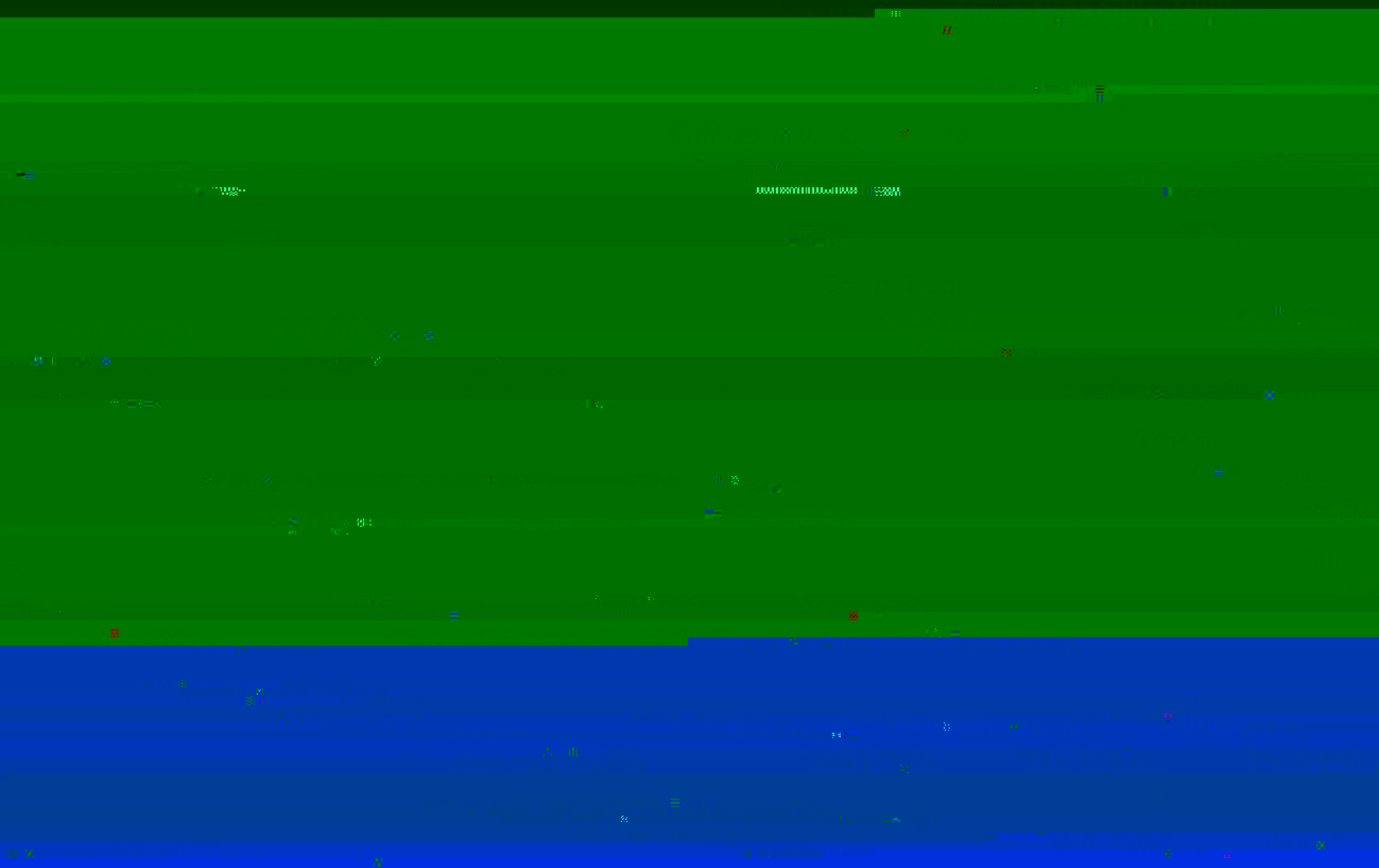
