**SUMMARY STATEMENTS**

**Spring 2007 Enrollment**

***New Students:***

Undergraduate: The **517** new undergraduates who registered this semester represent **17** first-time freshmen, **434** transfer students, and **66** readmitted students.

Graduate: The **82** new graduate students enrolled include **78** first-time graduate students and **4** transfer students.

***Doctoral Program in Physical Therapy:***

There are currently **18** students enrolled in the DPT program and **47** students enrolled in the Transitional DPT program.

***Headcount & FTE:***

Total Population: There are **6,930** students registered, generating **5,889** FTE.

Undergraduate: The college enrolled **6,433** students this semester generating **5,626** FTE.

Graduate (including post baccalaureate): There are **497** students enrolled this semester with a corresponding FTE of **263**.

***Matriculated vs. Non-Matriculated Students:*** The percentage of matriculated undergraduate students increased from **97% to 98%** while the percentage of matriculated graduate students increased from **76% to 80%**.

***Credit Load:*** Undergraduate credit load increased from 13.8 credits per student to **14.0** credits per student. Graduate students' average credit load decreased to **6.3**

**AY 06-07 Annualized Headcount & FTE\*\***

***Total Population:*** The combined annualized headcount is 7,072 students, which exceeds last year's figure by **3.1%**. Annualized FTE increased by **3.59%**

***Undergraduate:*** The AY06-07 annualized headcount for undergraduate students is **6,580** an increase of 3% from the AY05-06 annualized headcount. The corresponding FTE is **5,756**, an increase of 3.5% over last year's figure of 5,559.

***Graduate (including post baccalaureate):*** The graduate annualized headcount is **492**, an 11% increase, and **269** FTE, a 4% increase.
