Galloway Twp., - The Richard Stockton College of New Jersey and Atlantic Cape Community College have entered into an Articulation Agreement for a new Dual Degree Program (DDP) that promises to benefit local students by increasing degrees earned, and reducing the cost of their education.

The agreement, formalized with a signing ceremony today, also streamlines the transfer and admission process into Stockton. Upon successful completion, students earn an Associate in Arts or Associate in Science degree from Atlantic Cape as well as their Stockton Baccalaureate degree in their chosen program of study.

Stockton President Herman J. Saatkamp and Atlantic Cape Community College President Peter Mora officially signed the agreement in the Grand Hall of Stockton's Campus Center.
