



LoBiondo Maintains Lead in 2nd Congressional District Race

Galloway Township, NJ – The Stockton Polling Institute released its second poll of the 2nd Congressional District showing Republican incumbent Frank LoBiondo leading Democratic challenger Cassandra Shober by a margin of 54 percent to 34 percent. In the September poll, Congressman LoBiondo had a similar lead of 55 percent to 34 percent.

In the race for the United States Senate seat, incumbent Democratic Senator Robert Menendez still leads Republican challenger Joseph Kyrillos by a 56 to 33 percent margin in the 2nd Congressional District. The margin is the same as the first poll conducted in September.

Cassandra Shober improved her recognition in that 49 per cent had an opinion of her while only 44 percent had an opinion of her in the last poll. In this poll, 32 percent had a favorable opinion of her and 17 percent had an unfavorable opinion. That is somewhat improved from the previous 31 percent favorable and 13 percent unfavorable in the previous poll.

LoBiondo's job performance in this poll (56 percent excellent or good) and (35 percent fair or poor) is essentially the same as in the last poll (57 percent excellent or good and 36 percent fair or poor).

Only 18 percent of the voters approve of the job performance of Congress (up from 14 percent), while 81 percent disapprove (down from 84 percent).
