RESOLUTION CALLED RICHARD STOCKTON'S LEGACY  
DENOUNCING WHITE SUPREMACY WITHIN STOCKTON UNIVERSITY

Whereas the Stockton University Student Senate is the elected voice of approximately 9,000 students who attend Stockton University, and that

Whereas the students of Stockton University have displayed a concern about the placement of the Richard Stockton and the glorification of Richard Stockton in the proposed exhibit, responses of institutional racism within Stockton University; and

Whereas the report was derived from students at the Student Senate's open forum regarding the legacy of Richard Stockton on our campus on September 20, 2017 and

Therefore, the Stockton University Students for Democratic Society have delivered a strong demand and the following four points are listed in the recommendation

1. Create a protocol that is easily accessible for the entire Stockton University community that will inform students, faculty, and staff within 24 hours of the situation.
2. Revoke the current Student Code of Conduct adopted by the Office of Students Rights and Responsibilities relating to social justice, discrimination, harassment, and retaliation, to be more specific. Enact strict sanctions on students who violate the Student Code of Conduct in bias incidents and discrimination.
3. Reaffirm Stockton University's commitment to denounce white supremacy / racism by removing symbols that glorify or are representative of white supremacy, including the Richard Stockton bust and any glorification of Richard Stockton, especially in the proposed university exhibit.
